



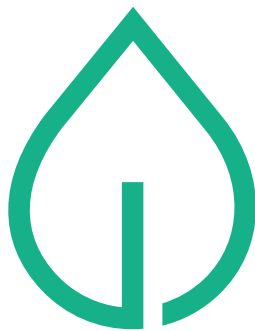

RENEWABLE ENERGY



USING WASTE AS A RESOURCE

In 1985, Granger became the first company in Michigan to harness the power of landfills as a renewable source of energy. Since then, decomposing waste in Granger landfills has been continuously used to generate renewable energy in some form or another.

Renewable energy company EDL opened Lansing's first renewable natural gas (RNG) facility in 2021. The facility extracts approximately 22,000 tons of waste gas from Granger Waste Services' Wood Street Landfill and converts it into approximately 870,000 mmBtu of RNG each year.

EDL also operates Grand River Generating Station, which uses landfill gas from Granger Waste Services' Grand River Avenue Landfill to generate 3.2 megawatts (MW) of electricity.

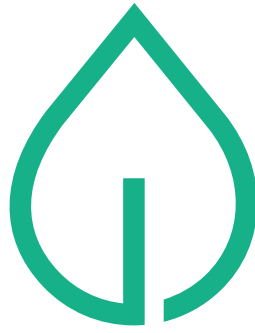
